How Collaboration with Local Charities and Sustainable Practices Make a Difference

When companies like Kumon join forces with community charities, they can efficiently extend aid to low-income communities and positively impact their environment.

In 2023, during our annual Associate Holiday Potluck, we organized a Coat & Winter Essentials Drive to support the Children's Breakfast Club. The Toronto Branch successfully met our goal, donating over 100 pieces. Building upon this commitment, we expanded our reach by contributing to two additional charities: the Regen Outreach Community, a Brampton-based food bank, and the Albion Boys & Girls Club, dedicated to assisting low-income families with after-care.

With three charity boxes, we broadened our charity event to include not only Associates but also Toronto Instructors at the Instructor Holiday Luncheon. We were overwhelmed by the response received from both groups. Our donations included large bundles of used clothes, surplus food goods, and unused toys, combating the issue of rising waste.

Canadians, on average, purchase 70 new articles of clothing annually, contributing to the 12 million tons of waste dumped into landfills each year. Additionally, 58% of all food produced in Canada is wasted before reaching grocery stores, and 80% of purchased toys end up in landfills.



Through contributions we can significantly impact the lives of our local community members and our environment. The Kumon Toronto Branch donated an impressive 80 pounds of food to the Regen Outreach Community, and the Albion Boys & Girls Club expressed their heartfelt appreciation for the donated toys, while the coats and winter parcels provided were gratefully received by the Children's Breakfast Club.
