

Kumon North America Honored for Environmental Work

The New Jersey State Senate and General Assembly have acknowledged KNA's contributions to the community by passing a joint resolution recognizing Kumon as "highly esteemed within the Garden State." The resolution pays tribute to Kumon's "meritorious history of service and commitment to the citizens of Bergen County."

The resolution was sponsored by Senator Loretta Weinberg, Senate Majority leader. Her district includes the town of Teaneck, where Kumon's North American headquarters is located. She became aware that KNA had created a small grove in a local park and that KNA associates have volunteered at a nearby nature conservancy. Senator Weinberg noted that Kumon has "demonstrated an exemplary dedication to the environment" and that "Kumon North America and its employees have given generously of their time and energy to benefit our natural world." The resolution also noted that "the Company's Green Team is especially noted for its dedicated volunteer work."



Senator Weinberg presented a framed copy of the resolution to KNA on October 26, 2016. KNA also received a Certificate of Commendation from the Bergen County Board of Freeholders and an Award for Excellence from the Teaneck Creek Conservancy.
